Travel about 8km, and turn left into Neich Road. Travel 800m and turn right at T Junction. Travel 450m and turn left into Pebbly Hill Road. Follow Pebbly Hill Road for about 4km until it meets Mitchell Park Road at a T intersection. Turn right and follow this road into Mitchell Park.
National Park Parking
Please be aware that parking in the National Park will cost \$7 per car - unless you are a member of the National Parks. There is a Pay and Display machine at the entrance to the park. If you consider parking outside the park, the walk to the start is approximately 1km. Sharing the cost of parking with others by car-pooling is also an option.
